"Not one penny. We receive nothing from them, and the amount of money they get nationally and don't share with needy shelters like ours is a shame."

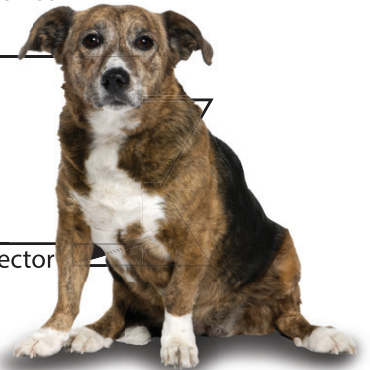
