



Items to Be Seized

Items consistent with the manufacture of improvised explosive devices, including specifically,

1. Electrical device components necessary to the construction and/or detonation of IED devices;
2. "Methyl ethyl ketone", and/or container (s) bearing lettering "M.E.K.";
3. Ammonium nitrate, including the residue of ammonium nitrate;
4. Fusing system(s), time-delay, safe separation mechanisms, be they electrical, mechanical, or nonelectric, batteries, and/or other sources of power, a burning type fuse, chemical delays, wiring, tape, adhesives and assorted fasteners;
5. Timers, mechanical and/or electric;
6. Mechanical or hand tools needed to construct an improvised explosive device and fusing system, including but not not limited to, screwdrivers, pliers, fingernail clippers, hammers, knives, and other tools;
7. Any and all documents, photographs, papers, written materials, books, diagrams, schematic drawings, video tapes, computer generated or stored information or other materials which relate to the manufacture, construction and/or assembly of improvised explosive devices or any of the components thereof.
8. Any and all documents, papers, written or printed materials, computer generated or stored information or other materials and indicia which relate to:

A. The message of August 29, 2003, from the Animal Liberation Brigade posted on an electronic bulletin board at Biteback Magazine that is accessed through www.directaction.info which states in part:

"In the early hours of August 28th volunteers from the Revolutionary Cells descended on the animal killing scum Chiron. We left them with a small surprise of 2 pipe bomb filled with an ammonium nitrate slurry with redundant timers. This action came about because Chiron has continued their murderous connection with Huntingdon Life Sciences even though they have been exposed

numerous times as some of the most egregious animal killers in the industry.

B. The message of September 30, 2003, was posted on Biteback Magazine which states in part:

"On the night of September 25th volunteers from the Revolutionary Cells attacked a subsidiary of a notorious HLS client, Yamanouchi. We left an approximately 10lb ammonium nitrate bomb strapped with nails outside of Shaklee Inc, whose CEO is both the CEO for Shaklee and Yamanouchi Consumer Inc. We gave all of the customers the chance, the choice, to withdraw their business from HLS. Now you all will have to reap what you have sown. All customers and their families are considered legitimate targets.

9. Any and all receipts, invoices, purchase orders, sales slips or other documents and materials relating to the purchase or procurement of any and all materials and tools which have been used, can be used, or intended to be used in the design, manufacture and construction of improvised explosive devices;
10. Any and all receipts, invoices, or other documents relating to the rental of or access to or control over other vehicles, residences, garages, storage sheds, storage lockers, and other locations over which the person building the bomb has custody or control.
11. Clothing of Daniel Andreas San Diego, which may be seized for a reasonable period of time to conduct a thorough forensic examination for residue of materials relevant to improvised electronic devices;
12. The Honda Civic, VIN: 2HGEJ2142PH517162, displaying California license plate 3EKT501 (the subject vehicle) may be seized for a reasonable period of time to conduct a thorough forensic examination. Within ten days of the seizure of said vehicle, the United States shall report to this Court the progress of said inquiry. *Vehicle to be returned within 10 days unless*

Further order by the Court.
